<b>Outline</b>	<p>The Scottish Curling Funspiel is a one day event open to junior members from the same junior curling club. There are two categories: Under 13 and Under 15.</p> <p>Teams are guaranteed a minimum of 3 x 4 end games and a final will be played. Teams will also compete in a Hotshots competition throughout the day.</p> <p>Teams are allowed two substitutes throughout the competition. A substitute / player may be able to play for more than one team at any weekend.</p> <p>Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> teams and Hotshot winning team</p>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Teams can be male, female or mixed.</li><li>• All team members must be members of Scottish Curling.</li><li>• All team members must be less than 13 or 15 years of age by the end of the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 2018 as appropriate.</li></ul>
