

The Scottish Curling Mixed Championship 2018-2019 Entry Form



- Outline** The Scottish Curling Mixed Championship is for any two eligible males and females competing for the title and the right to represent Scotland in the World Curling Championships (venue and date TBA).
- Eligibility**
- Teams must be mixed (2 males & 2 Females playing in alternate positions)
 - All team members must be members of the Scottish Curling.
- Date** Championship is held at The Peak (Stirling) - 25th to 27th May 2018.
- Entry Fees** £200 per team
- Payment can be made by cheque, over the phone or by bank transfer (BACS).
When paying by bank transfer, you must reference the team name and the competition
**Do not process payment until confirmation of your place has been received by Scottish Curling Office.*

- Closing Date** 31st January 2018.
Scottish Curling reserves the right to extend the entry period should spaces be available.
- Rules** Competitors will at all times abide by the current [Rules of the Game](#).
WCF sweeping regulations will be enforced for this competition.
- Championship - May be comprised of league sections with at least the winners and runners-up qualifying for the knockout stages.
- In all round robin games the method of scoring will be one point awarded for each win. Neither shots nor ends shall affect the ranking.
- In the event of a tie in any game an extra end or ends shall be played to determine a winner. Where two or more teams are tied for a qualifying position ranking shall be determined in accordance with C9: Ranking Procedure.
- All games are normally 8 ends; a minimum of 5 ends must be completed.
- Substitution must satisfy eligibility criteria. If a substitute is unavailable for the remainder of the game then the alternating gender order must be maintained.
- The winning team shall represent Scotland in the World Mixed Curling Championships. See C12: International Representation.
- Code of Conduct** This event is covered by Scottish Curling Codes of Conduct for players and their associates (coaches, parents and supporters) as well as the rules of the game and of the competition. By entering a team and returning this form the team and all their associates agree to abide and be bound by them. The Code of Conduct can be found at [Rules of the Game](#). Any breach of the Code of Conduct may be dealt with under Scottish Curling disciplinary procedure and guidelines.
