

Terms and conditions for Scottish Curling prize draws

1. Our "Prize Draws" are organised by The Royal Caledonian Curling Club (trading as: Scottish Curling) of Ochil House, Springkerse Business Park, Stirling, FK7 7XE. We are the national governing body for the sport of curling in Scotland. A company limited by guarantee, not having a share capital and not distributing profit. All proceeds from our prize draws will be used to further the objectives of the organisation and to develop the sport of curling.

The Scottish Curling team shirt sponsorship Prize Draw is taking place in 2018 for the first time. It is intended for companies to enter the prize draw and all entries will receive:

- **2 tickets to the Scottish Curling Championships finals on 16 February 2019**
- **Private sponsors reception on 16 February 2019**
- **Your company logo on the Scottish Curling website**
- **Your logo included in an article about the draw in the YourCurler e-zine, readership 8,000**

The winners of each draw will also be given:

- **A feature article on the Scottish Curling website**
- **Promotional social media posts to our 9,000 followers**
- **Press release announcing the sponsorship**
- **Your company logo on the sleeves of the team shirts**

How to enter

2. Entries must be received by six hours before the published time of the draw, which shall be the closing date, any entry received after the stated closing date will not be accepted.

- The Shirt Sponsorship Prize Draw will commence at 8pm on 12 Dec 2018
- Therefore the closing date will be 2pm on Wednesday 12th December 2018

3. Entry to our prize draws can be made by hand, by post, by email or other electronic means or telephone and must be accompanied with payment or followed up with payment prior to the time and date of the draw. Scottish Curling will not accept responsibility for entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.

4. After receipt of your entry, you will be asked to provide the logo/artwork that you wish to be used on Team Scotland sleeves as well as on our website, newsletter and promotional material. The logo will be required to meet the standards set and approved by the World Curling Federation.

5. By submitting an entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. If you have any questions, please contact office@scottishcurling.org

6. Scottish Curling reserves the right to refuse entry or refuse to award the prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.

Eligibility

7. Unless otherwise stated, our prize draws are open to all except employees of Scottish Curling.

8. Entrants must be at least 16 years of age.

9. Multiple entries may be made by any individual or organisation.

10. In entering, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win. Scottish Curling may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the prize draw.

11. Scottish Curling reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize draw.

The Draw

12. Winners will be chosen by random draw, performed at the time and place specified on the entry form and on the Scottish Curling website. The draw will be published live on Facebook.

13. The winners will receive details of the prizes and the process for fulfilment.

14. The winners will be notified if present at the draw or by email or telephone (using details provided at entry) within 24 hours of the draw.

15. The winners will be offered the opportunity to see a proof of the artwork on the team clothing before the event.

16. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. Scottish Curling reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal value if circumstances beyond Scottish Curling's control makes it necessary to do so.

17. The decision of Scottish Curling regarding any aspect of the prize draw is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.

18. The list of winners will be published by Scottish Curling or can be obtained by sending a request for information in the form of an email to office@scottishcurling.org within 60 of days after the date of the closing date of the prize draw.

19. Scottish Curling reserves the right to hold void, cancel, suspend, or amend the promotion where it becomes necessary to do so.

Limitation of liability

20. Insofar as is permitted by law, Scottish Curling, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winners or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of Scottish Curling, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

Data protection and publicity

22. By entering, you agree that any personal information provided by you with your entry may be held and used by Scottish Curling or its agents and suppliers to administer the competition.

Governing law
