Outline	<p>The Curlability Bonspiel is open to all curlers especially those with a disability / impairment which may limit them from entering other Scottish Curling / SWCA competitions. This will include those who stick curl or short curl, as well as those with a Vision / hearing impairment, Autistic Spectrum Disorders, learning disability or who use a wheelchair.</p> <p>Entry to the competition is on an individual basis and teams will be compiled on or shortly before the day of the event. Teams may be split into newcomer / experienced sections if there is demand.</p> <p>Teams playing are guaranteed a minimum of 3 games of 4 ends. Some curlers may take part in some shotmaker / skills challenge activities as well as an alternative, if more appropriate.</p>

Entry Fees	<p>£10.00 per entrant for Scottish Curling members £15.00 per entrant for non-members (This will incorporate a Scottish Curling supporter's membership, allowing you to keep up-to-date with Scottish curling news and events, but does not allow entry to standard Scottish Curling Competitions)</p> <p>Entrance fee includes tea / coffee / biscuits during the break.
