Junior Mixed Doubles Event

24-26 November 2023

Rules

- This event will be played with 4 groups of 6 teams in a round robin format.
- There will be a 5 minute practice before each game. With first practice starting 15 minutes before game time.
- Before each round robin game, teams will carry out a coin toss to determine first or second practice and stone colour.
- The winner of the coin toss will have choice of either practice or stone colour. *E.g If the team chooses second practice, then other team has choice of stone colour and first practice.*
- At the conclusion of practice an LSD will be carried out by 1 player of each team.
- Games will be 8 ends with a minimum of 5 ends being played. 1 extra end will be played if needed. If scores are level the extra end 1 draw to the button will be played.
- Stone position will be position 2 unless stated otherwise by ice staff. *This will be confirmed before the first game.*
- Teams will choose 5 from 8 stones to use during the game. 2 stones will be marked as the placed stones.
- There are no time outs.
- Players will carry out their own game measures.
- Teams are responsible for setting the placed stones at the start of every end.

Brushes

- The new Rules in relation to Brooms **will be** enforced during this Competition.

Playoffs

- Top 2 teams from each group will qualify for the play off stages.
- Team will play LSD at the end of their practice in playoff games to determine hammer.
- Higher ranked team will have choice of stone/practice.
- If teams have same ranking (e.g A1 vs C1) then a coin toss will be carried out.

Ranking

- Teams will be ranked by Win/Loss record.
- Playoff ranking will be used as per Scottish Curling rule C9b.

Mixed Doubles Rules

- General Mixed Double rules can be found in the Scottish Curling Rule book R14.
