All agreed based on junior consultation that a rule change is likely for the Junior Championships.
CG and JM to liaise with rules convenor that for junior champs in the case of illness or injury another member can be brought in from a previous team who played in qualifiers. This is limited to only 1 player so the team can't bring in two new players.
CG and JM to speak to rules convenor around ALL competitions in that they must START with 4 players but can drop down to 3 in the event of illness or injury during the competition.
- 6. Seniors / Masters Championships**
Discussion around changing the finals of both these competitions to 8 teams was agreed by committee

Anything above 8 a qualifier is required even if it is 9 teams. Allows for better planning and scheduling, means there are no perceived stronger / weaker sections as all teams play a round robin format.

7. Mixed merging participants with Senior Mixed **KW**

Should this be a 1 day event? 1 team entered in the end before closing date no entry for this season

Do we work with events already in place ie British open and the winner goes to World mixed.

A lot of discussion was around this event and will Scotland not have any representation attending. The WC event was due to be held in Qatar but that is hugely unlikely to go ahead in that venue so it was agreed that a solution would be sought after venue is confirmed with committee discussing a number of options.
